Description

Lists all function conflicts between epiverse packages and other packages that you have loaded.

Usage

```
epiverse_conflicts(only = NULL)
```

Arguments

`only` Set this to a character vector to restrict to conflicts only with these packages.

Value

An object of class `epiverse_conflicts`, invisibly. Printed output shows which epiverse functions mask functions from other packages.

Examples

```
## Not run:
epiverse_conflicts()

## End(Not run)

epiverse_packages	<i>List all epiverse packages</i>

Description

Returns the names of all packages included in epiverse, read from the package DESCRIPTION file at runtime.

Usage

```
epiverse_packages(include_self = TRUE)
```

epiverse_packages

Arguments

`include_self` If TRUE, includes "epiverse" itself in the list. Defaults to TRUE.

Value

A character vector of package names.

```
